Poultry Water Nipples



Supplies

Package Contents:

- Waterer nipples
- Wing nuts
- Rubber Washers

You will Need:

- Electric drill
- 3/8" Drill Bit



Step 1: Drill Holes

- Install drill bit into drill
- Mark the hole centers, spaced evenly around bucket, 1 inch above the bottom of the bucket. Make sure to consider where you plan to put the waterer in your coop, so you don't have a water nipple out of reach of your chickens. Pro tip: use the waterer nipple to line up height of hole. (image 2)
- Drill holes where marked

Step 2: Prep Waterer Nipples

• Put a gasket on the waterer nipple (or make sure one is there) so the gasket will end up on the outside of the bucket when installed.

Step 3: Insert Waterer Nipples

- Screw the threaded end of the nipple into the container from the outside until the rubber washer is compressed (image 3). The metal pecking rod and water catch should be on the outside, with the water catch positioned (underneath the pecking rod) closest to the bottom of bucket (image 4).
- Repeat for the remaining nipples.





Step 4: Screw on Wingnuts

• Screw a wingnut onto the back of each nipple waterer (inside of the container) until it is snug to the side of the container (image 5).
