

# Poultry Water Nipples



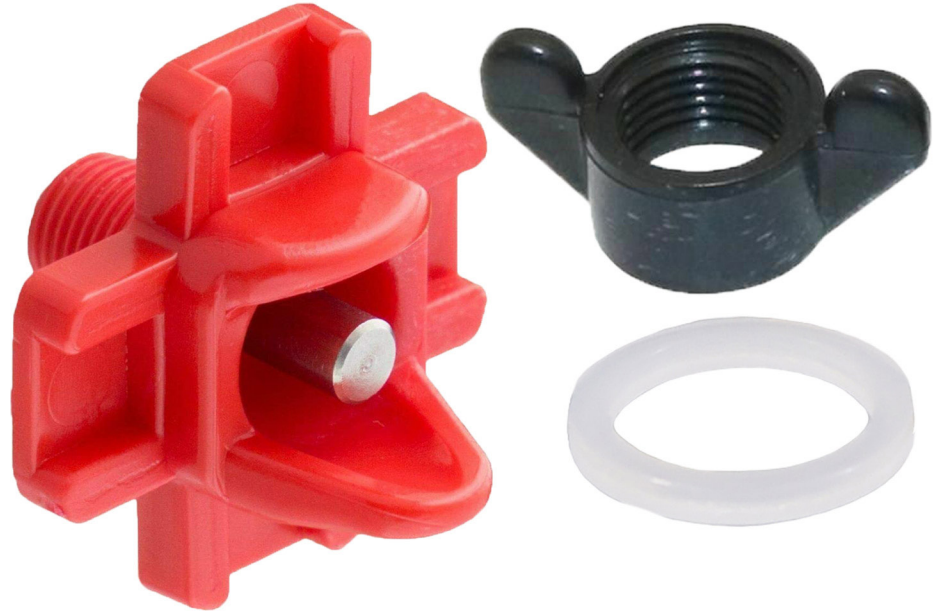
## Supplies

### Package Contents:

- Waterer nipples
- Wing nuts
- Rubber Washers

### You will Need:

- Electric drill
- $\frac{3}{8}$ " Drill Bit



## Step 1: Drill Holes

- Install drill bit into drill
- Mark the hole centers, spaced evenly around bucket, 1 inch above the bottom of the bucket. Make sure to consider where you plan to put the waterer in your coop, so you don't have a water nipple out of reach of your chickens. **Pro tip:** use the waterer nipple to line up height of hole. (image 2)
- Drill holes where marked

## Step 2: Prep Waterer Nipples

- Put a gasket on the waterer nipple (or make sure one is there) so the gasket will end up on the outside of the bucket when installed.

## Step 3: Insert Waterer Nipples

- Screw the threaded end of the nipple into the container from the outside until the rubber washer is compressed (*image 3*). The metal pecking rod and water catch should be on the outside, with the water catch positioned (underneath the pecking rod) closest to the bottom of bucket (*image 4*).
- Repeat for the remaining nipples.

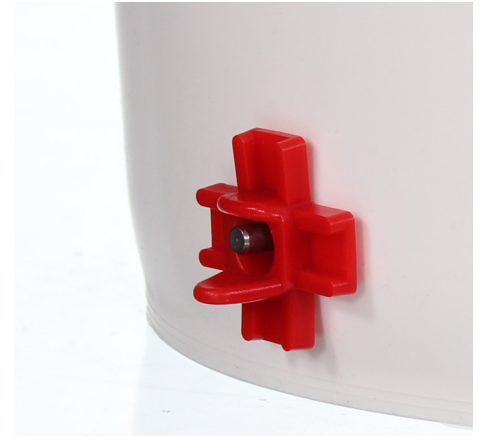

## Step 4: Screw on Wingnuts

- Screw a wingnut onto the back of each nipple waterer (inside of the container) until it is snug to the side of the container (*image 5*).
